1. Using "and" after hundreds e.g. 235 (two hundred and thirty). Furthermore, when you are talking about years from 2001 onwards, say "and" after the thousand, e.g. 2009 (two thousand and nine).
2. With indirect questions don't use the auxiliary verb "do/does/did" but change the verb form e.g. Do you happen to know how much it costs.

We'll practise indirect questions more next time.
